



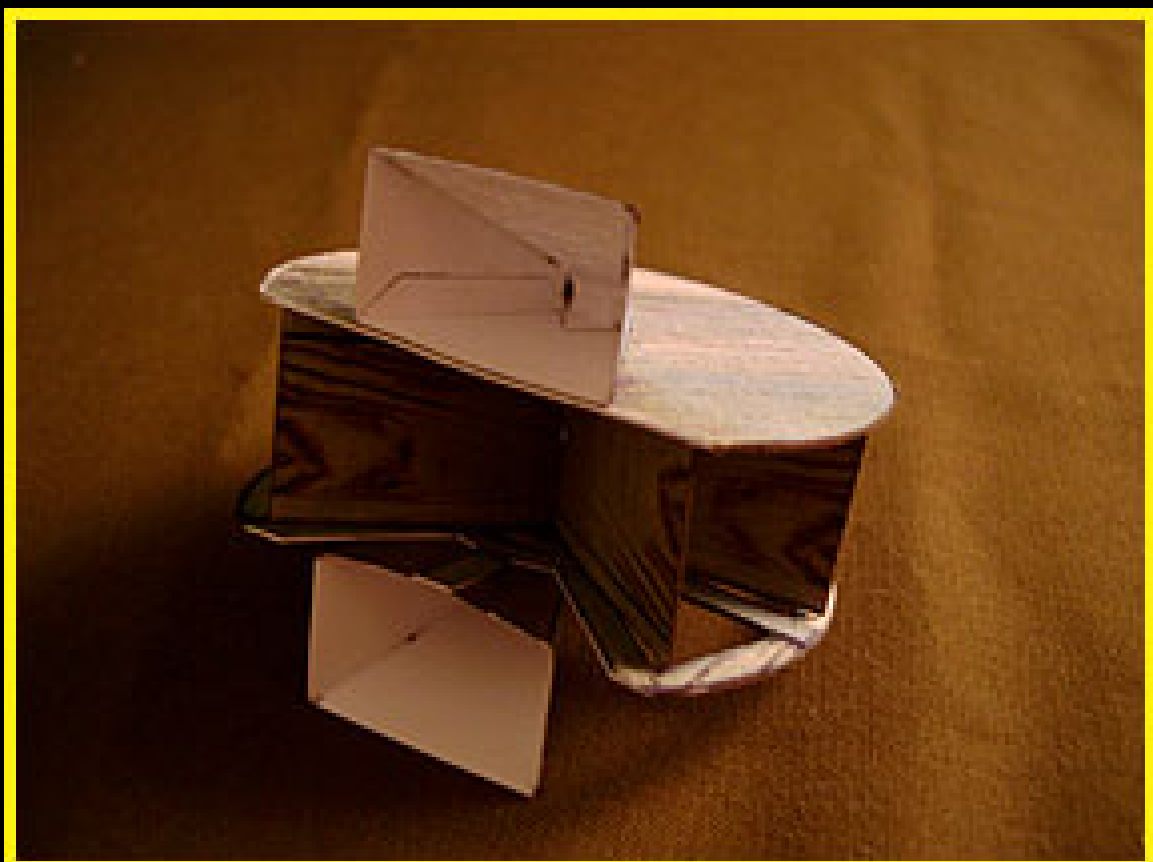
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THE MILL

- Cut, fold and score where noted. Remove the wheel sections as one rectangular piece.
- If you have folded the treads properly you should wind up with two accordion like shapes. Glue each individual tread section together. You should now have two sets of three blades and one extra blade.
- Fold and glue your rectangular wheel section and allow to dry. Once dry cut out the semi circle. At this point you may opt to remove the black areas from between the struts but this is optional.
- Place the solid wheel struts side up and begin gluing the treads starting from the bottom of one side. The glue tabs on the treads should match up to the struts shown on the wheel. The extra single tread should be glued at the last bottom strut.
- Apply glue to the outside edge of the treads and place the outside wheel down in line with the struts. Keep constant pressure on this section for at least one minute.
- Construct the two stone bases.
- Glue each stone base to the center point of each wheel (see photos)
