

Briefly sidelined due to a serious head injury during the 3062 Championships, Kelley Metz was out of action for nearly a year before returning to the arenas in late 3063 and achieving a fifteenth-place ranking. Her come-back over the next few years was nothing short of astounding, as was her spectacular victory over Ervin Rebelke at the rebuilt Steiner Stadium, at the helm of a deadly *TiTs'ang*.

Proven on the battlefields of the Capellan-St. Ives War, the TiTs'ang is a brutal 'Mech and particularly fearsome at close range. In a joint venture with Ceres Metals Industries begun in 3065, Omnitech Industries has begun extensive

modifications on stock Ti Ts'ang shipped directly to their facilities on Solaris VII. Kelley Metz immediately fell in love with a variant that sacrificed over-all ground speed for Omnitech's new improved jump jets and the 300

VLAR supercharger.
