AIRPLANE TICKETS

These props are based on actual vintage airplane tickets.

Print on white or off-white paper. This prop is designed to be printed on both sides of the paper. Print page 2 of this file, then reinsert paper and print page 3 on the reverse.


Trim at solid black crop marks.

Put pages in order and **perforate** at dashed line through both layers. Use a perforating wheel, a dressmaker's pounce wheel, or a sewing machine without thread to perforate.

Staple pages together along left edge.

Cut a piece of black tape 31/4" long and 5/8" wide. **Wrap tape** around left edge of ticket booklet to cover staples, as shown below.

Enter passenger and trip information by hand.



Wrap black tape around edge to cover staples

TO MAKE ENVELOPE

Print on white or off-white paper.

Score at dashed lines.

Trim at solid black outlines.

Fold the back and side flaps over at scored lines and **glue** flaps to back of envelope. Flaps should be on the outside of the finished envelope.

Insert finished tickets and fold over top flap.

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CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- 1. Carriage/Transportation under this Passenger Ticket and Baggage Check, hereinafter called "ticket," is subject to the rules relating to liability established by the Convention for the Unification of Certain Rules Relating to International Carriage/Transportation by Air signed at Warsaw, October 12, 1923, if such carriage/transportation is "international carriage/transportation is a defined by said Convention.
