1923 US PASSPORT

This prop is an authentic replica of a US Passport from the early 1920s.

This cover is for either the full-size 18 x 12 inch passport insert or the two-piece 8.5 x 11 inch insert.

Print Inside Cover page on ordinary white or off-white paper.

Print Outside Cover page on light brown cardstock.

Score at dashed lines.

Trim at solid black outlines (TIP: round corners later, when cover is completely assembled)

Fold Inside Cover on scored lines to form a flap at the center, as shown at right.

Fold Outside Cover at scored lines to form narrow channel at center.

Glue back of Outside Cover to back of Inside Cover, as shown at right. (TIP: do one side at a time. Don't try to glue the whole thing at once.)

To insert passport page insert:

Fold the passport insert in half down the middle from top to bottom.

Glue insert to flap along upper left edge, as shown at right. -

To close passport, fold insert in half from bottom to top, then fold again in half from right to left, as shown at right. Close cover around folded insert.



A NOTE ABOUT PASSPORTS


Passports from different countries traditionally came in different styles, but after the first World War the League of Nations held a number of conferences in an attempt to standardize international transit and commerce. In the early/mid 'Twenties, a committee of the League of Nations recommended that all countries adopt a standard booklet-style passport, which was already common in some places. Although it usually ignored advice from the League, the U.S. gradually converted to the booklet style, and the US passport went through a couple of design changes in the time of Lovecraft. Hence, there are three styles of US passport in the HPLHS prop collection.


This fold-out, pre-League of Nations style is most appropriate for games set up to about 1926. The hardback booklet style is for games set in the late 1920s and early '30s, and the softback booklet style is for games set in the later 1930s - '60s.




