This prop is a replica of a genuine 1929 Massachusetts driver's license.

Enter driver information using Acrobat form fields, if desired, or erase default entries and print license blank. (For maximum authenticity, print blank and add information with a type-writer after license is printed.)

Print on buff or light yellow paper, if possible.

Score down the center at the dashed blue lines.

Fold at scored line, and glue front of license to back.

Perforate through both layers at dashed black line.

Trim top and bottom of license at solid red lines.

Tear off edge of license at perforation.

Sign license where indicated. Write or stamp date where indicated.

Fold license so name and address are visible.
