



To print your character standups, set your double-sided printer to short-edge binding and print on a cardstock material. Then, with child-safe scissors, use the outlines as guides to cut out the characters.

If you don't have a double-sided printer, print the pages individually and then glue them back-to-back with a thin, even coat of adhesive. Before glueing, hold the back-to-back sheets up to a light source to ensure they are lining up correctly.

The space between each character gives you a little bit of leeway if the two sides do not line up exactly.
