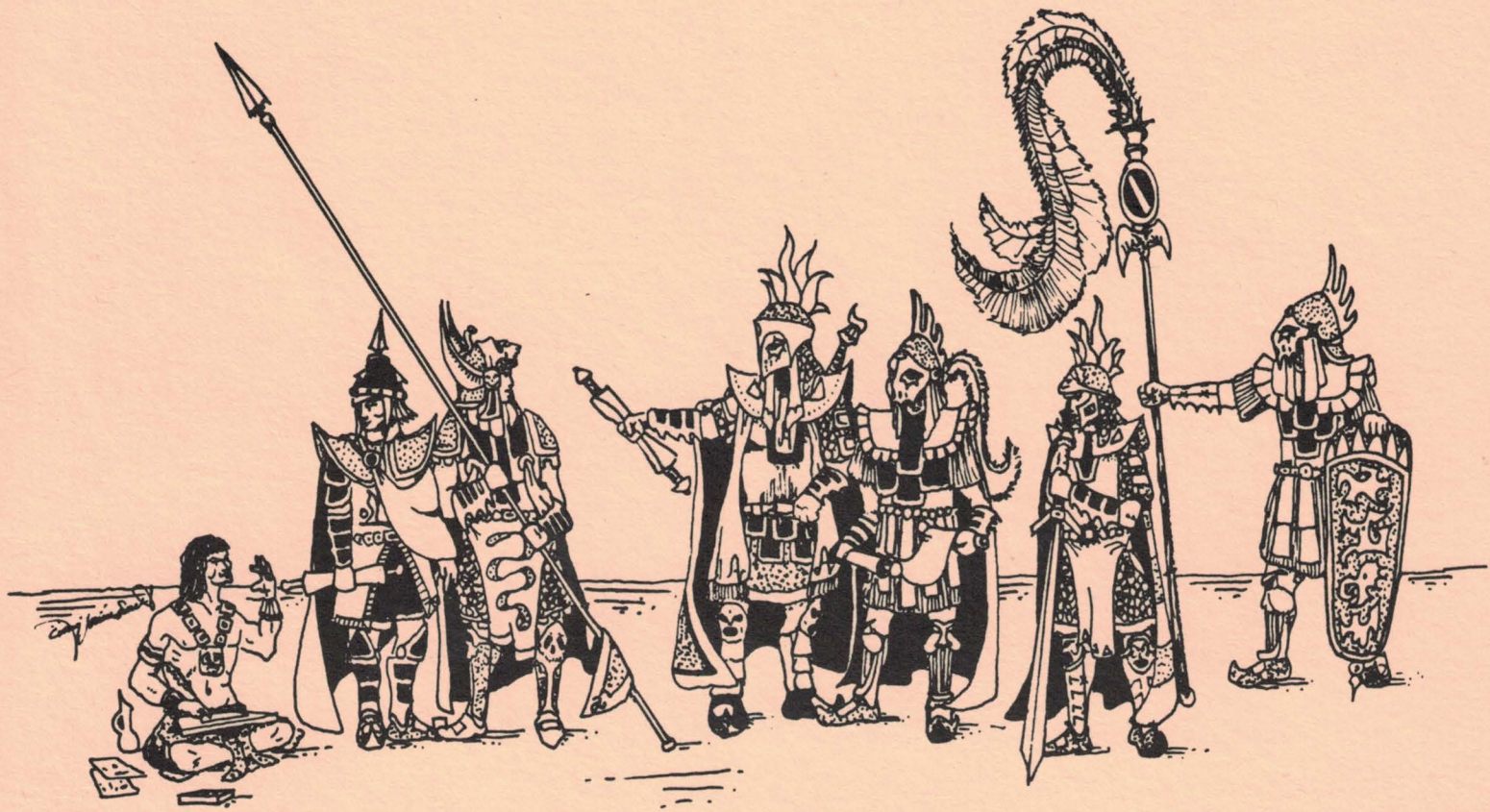

Preface

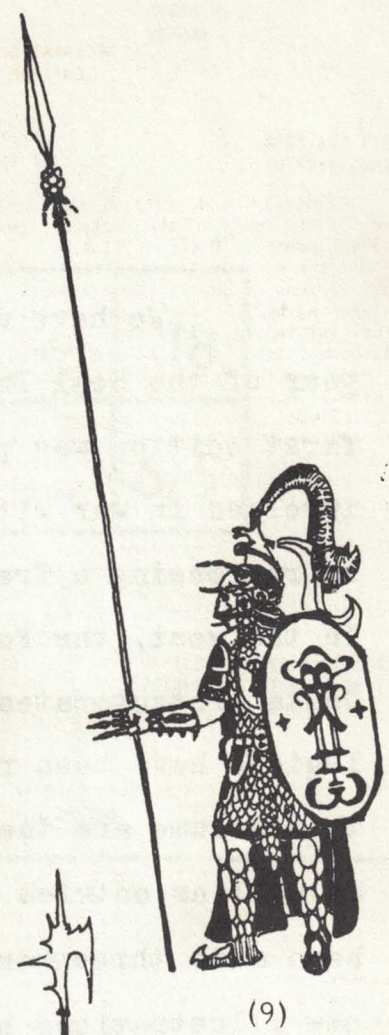
We have updated the entries in this list to the current year of the Seal Imperium: 2358 A.S. In the three years since the first edition was published, the Seal Imperium has found itself involved in war with the hostile Yan Koryani to the north, and in repressing a fresh incursion of the dreaded Ssu to the east. In the west, the Four Palaces of the Square brood over the lost Chaka Protectorates. To meet all of these challenges, six new legions have been raised, and the rest strengthened. Included in this volume are the statistics and special notes on the new units as well as entries in the Painting Guide. Also, corrections have been made throughout the text and entries. A special feature is new illustrations by Craig Smith.

Adventure Games has also published the second volume in this series which covers the Yan Koryani Alliance; miniatures enthusiasts can now game the war now raging on the Atkolel Heights using either "MISSUM" or "QADARDALIKOI" campaign rules. The set of maps ("The Northwest Frontier") done by Craig Smith are most useful for such campaigns.

To those who have waited for so long for new Tekumel-related materials, and to those who are exploring with us for the first time, both Prof. Barker and I give our thanks.

DECLAMATION OF THE GLORIES OF THE EVER-VICTORIOUS ARMIES OF THE SEAL
EMPEROR OF TSOLYĀNU, DIVINE GOD-KING OF THE SIDEREAL UNIVERSE.

The following descriptions present a cursory survey of the units of the Tsolyāni Imperial army as of the month of Didōm, 2359 A.S.

At the present time the Imperium fields some eighty legions of regular army troops. These are supplemented by (a) Sākbe road guards, (b) city guards, (c) temple guards organized by the various priesthods, (d) provincial and village guards and watchmen, and (e) private contingents maintained by individuals, clans, and noble families of the Empire.

Tsolyāni legions are categorized according to their equipment and arms, in turn creating a division according to function. Heavy Infantry are the elite of the army, and these troops are provided with complete armor of chlĕn-hide or metal, shields, helmets, and various weapons depending upon tradition and local customs. Medium infantry are less well armored; their body covering is thinner, made of lighter materials, and the thighs and groin area are often protected only by a cloth or leather kilt. Archers may be partially armored, but most wear only leather. Crossbowmen, on the other hand, tend to have armor equivalent to that of the medium infantry. Slingers are always light infantry, as are artillerymen and sappers. The two legions of marines are armored as mediums. The nonhuman and mercenary legions are equipped according to their national and racial customs, requiring special discussion.

Only a few legions of regular light infantry skirmishers are listed. More often, the Tsolyāni simply conscript peasants and villagers from surrounding areas according to the needs of the campaign. These troops have no more than an infrequent leather jerkin, helmet, or breastplate; and are armed with hunting spears, swords or maces, daggers, self-bows, and possibly light bucklers or wicker shields. It is assumed that every hundred square tsān or so can field about a thousand or so of these light troops on demand, and they are then organized into thousands, and commanded by a kāsī (cf. below) or perhaps molkār, detached from a regular legion for this purpose. When their duty is done, these light troops are allowed to return home. Some regular light skirmish legions do exist, of course, and these will be seen to be historically or culturally special in some way.

Estimates of reserves and troops in training are given below. Support and maintenance personnel are not listed. Supply trains, suttlers, transport corps, and other such rear-area types are not counted as part of a legion's strength, although each legion has them.

Tsolyāni legions consist of an historically traditional structure of twenty cohorts of 400 men each. Most legions are never able to achieve full strength, and some have as little as only four or five cohorts. Each legion is assigned a name and number (e.g. "The Legion of Giriktēshmu, 23rd Imperial Archers"), and it is then staffed under the watchful eyes of the High Military Commanders at Avanthār. The reader will note that there are many gaps in the numbering; this is due to the existence of numerous ancient, deactivated legions still on the rolls. A few of these do maintain a sketchy command structure and even a paper cohort or two, but in general they are truly defunct. Only the Tsolyāni love of tradition keeps them on the record. From time to time various legions have been officially removed from the records also, usually for political or religious reasons, and occasionally because of cowardice or poor military performances.

Imperial legions are largely financed by the revenues generated by the tax system of the Imperium. Avanthār oversees the equipping and paying of troops through the Palace of Ever-Glorious War, a branch of which exists in every Tsolyāni town of any size. Some legions are funded by temples desirous of currying favor with the Imperium, or wishing to achieve glory and honor for themselves. A few are provided

for by locally based clans, and one or two are financed by individual nobles. Once a legion is enrolled, however, its patrons must establish a special type of trust of land and/or money by which it will be financed in perpetuity. When a patron becomes insolvent or no longer wishes to fund an established legion, an appeal can be made to Avanthār to disband the unit. Occasionally the Imperium will then take over a legion and pay the troops itself, but more commonly the legion will indeed be deactivated. If troops are then needed in the area of the disbanded legion, the Imperium may authorize the founding of a new unit paid for by itself or by some other patron.

All Tsolyāni legions have the same command structure: the supreme commander is a kērdū (general); under him are two dritlān (colonel), each commanding one-half the unit; then there are two molkārs (majors). These officers make up the senior staff, and some legions may choose to have more than two dritlān or molkār level officers, as needed. The duties of the dritlān include the command of his wing, advising his general, and liaison duties with other legions. He is usually posted back with the general on a hill or other eminence from which he can see his troops and issue orders. He may also be detached with certain cohorts and given a special mission. He rarely joins in the fighting himself, although he may leave the central command post if need dictates. The molkār, on the other hand, is a field officer. He serves directly under the dritlān of his wing, and he takes his place in the field with his men, where he may be embroiled in the actual fighting. The molkār, too, may be detached for some special mission, while his dritlān takes over more direct command of the troops.

Each cohort is commanded by a kāsī (captain). Within a cohort, each hundred men are officered by a herēksa, and each twenty by a tirkāmu. (In eastern Tsolyāni this officer is called a tirdna.) The file of five men is the smallest subdivision of organization.

The legion standards, (the great kāng, emblems of ornately decorated gold, bright feathers, and colored chlĕn-hide held up on long poles) are kept back with the general. Each dritlān, molkār, and kāsī may carry smaller sub-standards, and the lesser subalterns wear special plumes to distinguish them from their troops. Each legion has its own uniform, shield colors and designs, etc., and even individual cohorts within a legion may choose to distinguish themselves by some special emblem on helmet or breastplate.

Each Tsolyāni legion thus has a maximum strength of 8,025 men: 20 cohorts of 400 men each, plus 20 kāsī who are not included in their cohorts, plus the five senior officers. A legion will also have a staff of scribes, messengers, liaison officers, recruiting officers (who are stationed in some other cities), quartermasters, and the other support troops discussed previously. The kērdū may also have a special bodyguard, for which he pays himself.

Most legions also have an auxiliary force of priests and magic-users. These are assigned by the Military High Command to serve in a combined force for each battle-group or "army". Magical forces are divided into an offensive and a defensive sub-unit: the former is charged with cooperating to hurl offensive spells at the enemy, while the latter's task is to block, negate, or counter the spells thrown by the foe in return. A good legion may expect to have about fifty to a hundred such priests and magic-users assigned to it on a permanent basis by its patron temple or by Avanthār. These specialists may be of whatever ranks the temple can find -- usually they are not the older and more senior priests and priestesses, since these persons may be too old for hard campaigning.

Battlefield magic is a matter of push against shove and not one of individual effort. Each sub-unit joins its minds collectively together to cast a powerful cumulative spell, striving to overcome the shifting strategies of the enemy magical units. When one side's magical contingents have been depleted, whether by exhaustion, or being slain or driven off the field, then do the opponent's enchantments really begin to get through to wreak maximum havoc. The magic-using contingent of a legion (or the combined force of a army group) stays well back from the fighting, preferring to stand on a hill or eminence near the command post of the kērdū.

Troops usually enlist in a legion devoted to their own personal deity (one of the ten gods or their allied cohorts). Men of different sects do occasionally serve together, but this is comparatively rare, and it is very uncommon indeed across the natural barrier of stability vs. change. A man who serves Karakān, the Lord of War, may thus choose to serve in a legion devoted to this deity; failing that, he may enlist in a legion favoring Lord Karakān's cohort, Chegārra, the Hero-King. If no opportunity to do so presents itself, he may then enroll in some other legion devoted to another of the Lords of Stability, but he would only very, very rarely enlist in a legion devoted to one of the Lords of Change. The same is true for the priests and magic-users. There are indeed a very few "neutral" legions, however, and some of the mercenary legions simply do not ask about a man's affiliations. In such cases -- and also when legions of different religious alignments are assigned to the same army group -- the devotees of the Lords of Stability will make up the defensive unit, and the followers of the Lords of Change make up the offensive spell-casters. Nationalism is far greater than the power of narrow sectarianism, as is true of the other empires of Tekumel as well.

Nonhumans usually prefer to serve in legions composed of their own kind. The Imperium has thus authorized "auxiliary" legions of Shēn, Hlāka, Pē Chōi, Pāchi Lēi, and Ahoggyā. Occasionally nonhumans may also be found in other units as well, and some legions present rather a mixed bag of odd individuals, particularly the mercenary legions of itinerant foreigners and adventurers.

The great antiquity of the Tsolyāni Imperium makes it difficult for outsiders to comprehend the weight of tradition and custom in the composition of the army and in the strategies and formations employed. Men prefer to fight with their own weapons and in their usual ways. Innovations are strenuously resisted, and a kērdū who attempts to teach his men something too different or too new may find himself replaced and transferred to a less sensitive post -- recruiting troops in Thrāya, for example.

Each legion has a history, often proud and glorious, always kept in view through regular ceremonies and rituals held in its barracks and clan-houses wherever it is stationed. The ancient kāng standards, the Gold of Imperial Glory granted to long-dead commanders, the tattered banners of a vanquished foe, the arms and armor of some great hero, the letters and decrees of the Imperium praising the legion; all these things are kept constantly in sight, and their glories are drummed into the heads of every new recruit. It is all but impossible to understand the Tsolyāni army without appreciating its multi-faceted history. It is not possible to provide the student of Tsolyāni culture with such histories here. These will be forthcoming at a later date.

Each legion is described in terms of (a) its title, (b) the name of its present commander, (c) its base-area, (d) its arms, (e) its strength, (f) its statistics showing the levels of its men, their special arms and armor, and various factors for use with the Missūm! miniature rules (the key to this section is included in this book), and (g) remarks.

Legions marked with an asterisk are pictured, also.

HEAVY INFANTRY:

(1) The Omnipotent Azure Legion*

Kērdū: Qorumā hiRi'inyūssa, Princes of the Legion
Based: Avanthār

Arms: Plumed helmets, full body armor, shields, swords, long spears, bows for seven cohorts
Strength: Twenty of twenty cohorts; two more in training in the mountains north of Avanthār; more enrolled, but not enlisted or trained

Remarks: The military strength given above does not include the special spy and police personnel operating under this legion's political arm, nor does it include the Emperor's deaf and dumb bodyguards at Avanthār (about 3,000 men). Recruits for this legion now outnumber any possible capacity to train and utilize them; the legion has thus revived the ancient Legion of the Portals of Destiny and has filled it with these extra recruits.

(2) The First Legion of Ever-Present Glory*

Kērdū: First General of the Empire, Kētukal hiMraktinē

Based: Sokātis; now mostly at Khirgār

Arms: Crested helmets, full armor, large shields, elaborate swords, long spears, five cohorts have short composite bows

Strength: Twenty cohorts; two more in training; approximately 1,000 additional men awaiting enrollment.

Arms: As for the Omnipotent Azure Legion; but only 1 cohort has bows
Strength: Twelve cohorts

(4) The Legion of Hnálla, Master of Light; 4th Imperial Heavy Infantry*

Kérdu: Technically Aknállu hiTikéshmu, High Priest of Hnálla at Běy Sý; actually commanded by Girgáshna hiVu'úrtesh, an experienced military priest of the temple in Běy Sý
Based: Běy Sý, some cohorts at Avanthār
Arms: Completely armored, tall crested helmets, long halberds, curved swords, small oval shields
Strength: Twenty cohorts; one in training in Běy Sý

Arms: Heavy visored helmet, full armor, articulated upper body armor, greaves, vambraces, etc.; long barbed pikes, elaborate curved swords, small round shields, four cohorts have bows

Arms: Tall conical helmets with mail aventails, rather archaic breastplate and armor style, hooked pikes, jagged-edged swords, small round shields, two cohorts have short composite bows
Strength: Eighteen cohorts, one in training on the island of Vrā

 Arms: Round spiked helmets, elaborate breastplates and vambraces, long spears, short chopping swords, oval shields, two cohorts have throwing clubs as well
 Strength: Sixteen; one in training at Butrus

Remarks: This ancient legion was disbanded during the time of Emperor Metlunél I "the Foolish," but it has now been revived (2,355 A.S.) by order of the Imperium to please Prince Mirusíya, who had spent much of his life amongst the old and aristocratic Vrídí clan of Fasítum. The Vrídí are considered politically somewhat dubious by the Imperium, but the Prince has endeavoured to conciliate them.

(11) The Legion of the Echoing Stone; 11th Imperial Heavy Infantry

Kérdu: Lord Ri'ísma hiZayóvu of Thayúri Isle
 Based: City of Tléku; now at Jakálla
 Arms: Heavy armor of archaic pattern, masked helmets, long kite shields, long spears, short maces, some short swords, one cohort has bows
 Strength: Seven cohorts; one still training on Thayúri

Shén: Males; black. Females and Egg-layers; black to dark gray on the undersides
 Pé Chóí: Males; gleaming black. Females; bone white. About three in four will be males
 Híáka: Dark brown to gray; females light gray. About three to one male/female ratio
 Páchi Léí: Males; dark green. Females; light greenish gray. 85% are males
 Ahoggyá: About 75% brown; 15% gray; 5% black; and 5% buff colored
