This was the official organization as of April, 1941. Artillery support is very heavy but artillery communication is almost non-existent. Also these long artillery columns were prime targets for the Luftwaffe and frequently never arrived with the rest of the division. Therefore, in most scenarios created for these divisions in the early part of the campaign, artillery should be very sparse.

Selected divisions received a battalion of tanks as well. Very few divisions received them and they would be older tanks, most likely no more than 3 or 4 T-26 counters.
