



The Italians once again defended Fort Capuzzo with a reinforced infantry company.



This strongpoint was halfway between Fort Capuzzo and Sollum and was defended by a reinforced infantry company.

This mobile reserve force was stationed somewhere behind the front ready to be deployed as needed.

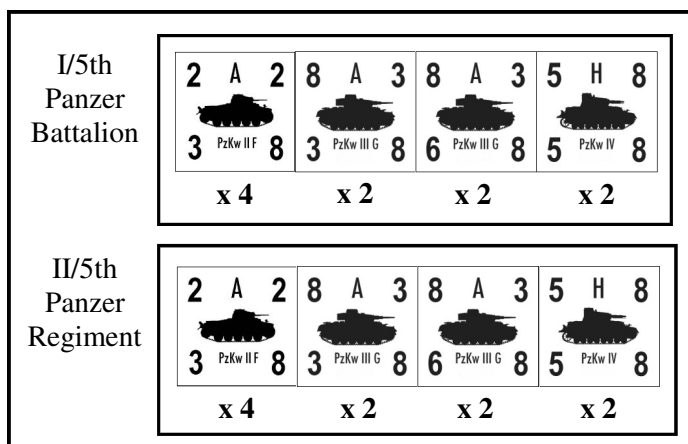
The Panzer battalions were again held in reserve behind the front, ready to launch a counterstrike at any breakthroughs.
