The 7th Support Group was to advance forward along the coast road and capture the lower part of Halfaya pass. It was then to push forward to Sollum and capture the town and the barracks there. The group ran into stiff resistance from the Italians at the foot of the pass and the position was only finally overrun at the end of the day with the help of the Australian anti-tank crews, operating as infantry. The group was able to occupy nearby Sollum by the end of the day as well but was pulled back from there the next day when the operation was halted.
