


2nd South African Infantry Division

The 2nd South African Infantry Division served most of Operation Crusader as a reserve unit providing security in the rear. In the late part of the campaign, it was used to help reduce Axis units isolated near the frontier. It later served in the 2nd garrison of Tobruk (with disastrous consequences!).
