The 2nd Panzer was a late addition to the Russian campaign, not arriving until October of 1941, after having participated in the Balkan campaign and having its tanks sunk on the return trip. The division served in Army Group Center and was in the vicinity of Moscow for most of 1942, fighting mainly defensive actions against the Russians.
