The 24th Panzer was a brand new division formed in the early part of 1942. It was sent to Army Group South for the summer offensive and by the end of the year was fighting in the battle for Stalin-grad. The division was destroyed when the Sixth Army was lost in early 1943. The division was re-formed later that year and served in the west for a while before returning to fight the Russians in late 1944. The 24th Panzer eventually survived long enough to surrender to the British in 1945.
