## Print on both sides Flip on long edge

This deck of playing cards is designed to be used with Saga of the Goblin Horde, and includes the following features:

- 1. Four jokers instead of the usual two, each with a suit.
- 2. Prominent "countdown numbers" at the top of each card. These are used for initiative: After dealing the cards, count down from highest to lowest to determine turn order.

3. A "saga symbol" at the bottom of each card. The symbols are improvisational prompts; an "elephant" could represent any sort of herd creature, or just something big, or it could be interpreted as strength, stamina, memory, etc. Likewise a "torch" might represent fire, heat, light, exploration, etc.

The saga symbols can be used as inspiration for the goblins' boastful tales and downtime activities, to add flavor to the adventure generator (draw one card for each scene), to flesh out complications during a chase, and so on.




