So the situation is rather a timeless classic... the adventurers have acquired more wealth than the combined riches of fifty kings, they've built their castles high, and now all they have to show for it is rooms full of coins and gems and drab, mundane furniture.

Release your wealthy characters from their simple clothes, boring furnishings, and dull, petty jewelry. Shower them with wonderful, unique items as you quickly drain their coffers dry. After all, once they've spent their last 35,000 gold pieces on a pair of garnet studded, dragon hide boots you'll be having fun watching the characters sweat over the division of treasure again.

THE LAYOUT OF THIS BOOK:

The volumes of Distinctive Items Of Snobbery are presented and laid out in a manner that makes for easy reading and reasonably easy generic conversion. While it may be the choice of most players to purchase the items listed in this volume the various assortments of goods can also be randomly rolled up if you so choose. The different elements concerning each item are described below.

Item: Quite simply, what the item is.

Roll: In case you wish to randomly roll these items up as miscellaneous treasure, use a twenty sided die and consult the roll table for the correct result of the dice rolls.

Weight: This is an estimated weight of the item. Some items are too small to accurately weigh.

Type: There are numerous different types of items. For easy reference an alphabetical code is provided. These codes are described below:

A= An Object Of Art. Art objects are sometimes a bit harder to sell on the open market as the exact value of an item of art often depends on the consumer's tastes.

C= Clothing. The described item functions as an item of clothing or clothing accessories. These items can be easily ruined unless stored properly and taken care of. Clothing items must also be regularly cleaned.

E= Equipment. Such an item makes for good adventuring equipment.

F= Furniture. Furniture items tend to be heavy and bulky but durable.

J= Jewelry. Jewelry items can sometimes be somewhat fragile or scratched up easily unless reasonable care is provided.

M= Miscellaneous. Some items simply lack an appropriate category.

Value: In this guide, a reasonably universal average in gold coinage is provided. While most all items in all volumes of Distinctive Items Of Snobbery shall be in terms of gold, standards for the lesser copper and silver coinages (as well as gold) is provided below to help the reader easily convert the exact worth of these items over to the fantasy role playing game system of their choice.

1copper= a small amount of money, equal in value to the purchase of a simple torch, a very small loaf of bread, or the petty offering to a beggar.

1 silver = a staple monetary sum, equal to a poor, unskilled laborer's work for one day or a plain, simple meal at a small inn. One silver coin is worth around ten copper coins.

1gold= a sum of money mostly used by skilled craftsmen, merchants, and aristocrats. One gold coin is worth around ten silver coins.

DESCRIPTION:

Agate Slab Dinner Table:

This beautiful dinner table features a surface of polished, banded agate slab and thick, sturdy legs made from gnarled, petrified wood with fittings of gold.

Agate Slab Parlor Table:

This beautiful parlor table features a surface of polished, banded agate slab and a legged stand made from gnarled, petrified wood with fittings of gold.

Basilisk Hide Bookmark: This lovely bookmark is made from worked basilisk hide and features numerous, tiny settings of garnet, blue quartz, and rose quartz.

Diamond Studded Belt Pouch:

This lovely leather belt pouch is worked from the hide of a young, green dragon and is lavishly covered with platinum and diamond studs. A platinum clasp is used to close the pouch and this clasp is in the shape of a maiden's head with flowing hair. Rubies serve the maiden's face for eyes.

Dragon Bone Bed: This bold, daring king sized bed is constructed from the ribs and leg bones of a slain red dragon with decorations of jade and fittings of brass and silver. Comfortable, feather padded mattresses are also included.

Dragon Hide Bookmark: This lovely bookmark is made from worked dragon hide and features numerous, tiny settings of garnet, citrine, peridot, topaz, onyx, and rose quartz.

Emerald Medusa Ring: This gold ring features a central emerald setting that is carved into the shape of a medusa's face with tiny ruby settings for eyes. The central setting is surrounded by numerous tiny settings of diamonds, peridot, and sapphires.

Garnet Studded Dragon Hide Boots:

These lovely boots are made of young, green dragon hide and lined with black mammoth fur. Studs of garnet and silver are secured along the sides of the boots and the straps of the boots feature buckles of gold with fittings of onyx and blue quartz.

Garnet Studded Dragon Hide Dagger Sheath: This noble, dagger sheath is made of young, green dragon hide and features studs of garnet and silver.

Garnet Studded Dragon Hide Sword Sheath: This daring, long sword sheath is made of young, green dragon hide and features studs of garnet and silver.

Ivory Hand Bowl: This lovely, carved, hand bowl is made of fine ivory.

Ivory Tusk Bed: This lovely, king sized bed features a wonderful, feather padded mattresses and a sturdy, lavish frame constructed from mammoth tusks and ribs with wrought brass fittings.

Jade Hand Bowl: This lovely, carved, hand bowl is made of fine jade.

Jade Parlor Table: This lovely parlor table is constructed from carved jade with numerous fittings of gold. The jade is engraved in a manner to resemble a multitude of wingless dragons intertwined around one another.

Painting: The Delights Of Torture:

This famous and quite decadent painting from the late Frandolis Blackgraspe measures 24" x 40" and is secured within a wrought silver frame decorated with large opal and onyx settings. The scene within the painting depicts the maidens of a small, remote village being tortured in a wicked and wonton manner.

Preserved Goblin Hand On Leather Strap:

This beautifully preserved goblin's hand is secured with a gold cap that is decorated with numerous settings of smoky quartz. The hand and cap is attached to a long, heavy neck strap made from cured, goblin hide leather. Silver studs and spikes decorate the neck strap.

Rose Quartz Chunk Bookend: This beautiful bookend features a heavy chunk of raw, rose quartz that is over 8" in diameter and mounted to a base of gold and exotic hardwood. Numerous smaller settings of blue quartz, garnet, and amethyst also decorate the bookend.


Ruby Crown: This majestic crown features a large, oval ruby setting and smaller settings of emerald, sapphire, diamond, and amethyst.
